

## TEMPORARY DUTY

1. Per Diem authorized IAW JTR and AFM 177-103.
  - a. AIRMEN: Government quarters and meals are available at Eniwetok.
  - b. OFFICERS: Government quarters are furnished at Eniwetok, and subsistence is provided by a contractor-operated mess.
2. Duties will be performed in one or all of the following countries or areas: Eniwetok atoll, Guam, Hawaii, New Guinea and surrounding islands, Australia and surrounding islands.
3. You are attached for administrative and logistical support to the Headquarters Squadron, 1502d ATW, Hickam AFB, Hawaii.
4. SPECIAL PROVISIONS:
  - a. You will have in your possession AF Form 246 (Record of Emergency Data); DD Form 737 (Immunization Certificate); Medical and Dental Treatment Records; Geneva Identification Card; Identification Tags; and AF Form 1226 (Record of Previous Convictions and Time Lost), if any.
  - b. Immunizations will be accomplished prior to departure IAW AFR 161-13.
  - c. Passports will be secured prior to departure IAW AFM 75-4.
  - d. Required clothing will accompany individual IAW existing supply directives.
  - e. Mail will be addressed to show: Grade, Name, AFSN, Aerial Survey Team #7, 1370 Photo-Map Wg, Navy No. 572, Fleet Post Office, San Francisco, Calif.  
Mailing address for DET #3 personnel: Aerial Survey Team #7, 1370 Photo-Map Wg, APO 953, San Francisco, Calif., 96553.
  - f. Personnel desiring to be paid per diem while on project will insure that they secure AF Form 1267 from Base Finance Officer prior to departure from home station.
  - g. Any additional requirements (photos, flight line badges, drivers license, etc.,) will accompany individual IAW existing directives. (This information can be obtained from AST Coordinator, Consolidated Personnel).
  - h. Tool kits and/or flying equipment will accompany those personnel required to utilize such equipment.
5. While traveling by air (commercial by TR or by military), 66 lbs baggage plus 100 lbs excess baggage, for a total of 166 lbs, is authorized.
6. In the event of limited war or mobilization, and you are traveling, you will contact this Headquarters to determine necessity for continuing travel. In the event of general war or if the continental United States is attacked by a foreign military force while you are enroute to the port, you will report to the nearest active Air Force installation as soon as possible.

### DEFINITION OF TERMS

LIMITED WAR = Conflict is restricted to a limited oversea area.

MOBILIZATION = The government mobilizes national resources to prepare for an all-out war.

GENERAL WAR = The area of conflict is unlimited and physical attack on the United States occurs or is expected.
